In order to change the poster below to suit your needs, please follow these directions:

- 1. If your kids are grown-up and you have grandkids who are immunized, change, "My kids are immunized!" to "My grandkids are immunized!"
- 2. To put a picture of your own kids or grandkids on the flyer:
 - a. Save a picture of your kids/grandkids to your computer.
 - b. Click on the picture that is currently in the poster. Hit "delete."
 - c. Go to the top tool bar in Word. Click on "Insert." Then "Picture," then "From File."
 - d. Find the picture you saved and select it. Hit "Ok."
 - e. Click on the corners of the picture to make it bigger. If the picture isn't in the spot you want it to be, right click on the picture. Choose, "Format" from the tabs and pick "Tight." You should be able to move the picture around.
- 3. To change the background color of the poster, go to the top tool bar in Word. Choose "Format" and "Background." Pick a color more suited to your tastes.
